

What papers should I take when I want to enter marriage with someone from abroad?

We need the original birth certificate from the country where the person comes from, and a marriage status certificate from the country where the person has lived as an adult, from one was 18 years old.

The certificate must not be more than 4 months old at the time for the ceremony.

The documents must be legalized, endorsed / stamped by the minimum in the country's Foreign Ministry / Department of Justice and finally the Danish Delegation in the country consulate / embassy.

For some countries, the documents can be legalized by "Apostille". See which countries are connected to www.um.dk "Apostille".

Then the papers, if not in English, it has to be translated into English at least, by a certified translator.

Passport and visa with valid residence in Denmark must be presented.

You must fill out the "Notice of Marriage", witness form and read the "Guide for the marriage of a residence permit in Denmark on the basis of marriage to a person living in Denmark", and sign the "Declaration of the Marriage Act § 11b on knowledge of the Aliens Act rules on family reunification" .

Once the above is in order and showcased in your municipality of residence, the ceremony can be planned.
